| SPEAKING  | Can give simple descriptions and communicate in everyday situations.                                    |

| READING   | Can read simple factual texts on familiar topics and understand the main information.                               |
| WRITING   | Can write straightforward connected texts on familiar topics and link ideas clearly.                                |
| LISTENING | Can understand the main points on familiar topics in clear standard language and follow straightforward narratives. |
| SPEAKING  | Can give straightforward connected descriptions and take part in conversations on familiar topics.                  |

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#### Level B2

| SPEAKING  | Can give clear descriptions on topics related to their fields of interest, explain personal views, and usually communicate fluently. |

| SPEAKING  | Can present complex subjects clearly and in detail and express themselves fluently with little effort.   |

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
